MONITORING KIT

PRODUCT NAME: Vertical Yellow Sticky Trap Kit for Olive Flies
PRODUCT CODE: BC 2240

PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

The Vertical Yellow Sticky Trap is made of a flat corrugated yellow plastic and coated both sides with the non drip, non drying AgriSense Trappit glue. The yellow colour is known to be attractive to Olive Fly. The attracted insects land on the trap and are stuck fast. Used in conjunction with the lure this trap is a simple and effective tool for insect monitoring.

RECOMMENDATIONS FOR USE

After unwrapping the outer covering carefully remove the trap to expose the sticky surface. The trap should then be hung using the accompanying wire. The lure is also attached using the hanging wire. Attention should be taken to avoid placing the trap where the sticky surface can easily come in contact with either the plants or fittings. Dispose of the wrapping correctly.

WHEN TO USE THE TRAP:

Traps should be installed before the first insects normally appear and maintained until the end of the season. The traps can be hung from branches at head height. In uniform large scale crops 1 trap per 5 hectares is normally sufficient while in non-uniform or small plots 1 trap per hectare is recommended. A minimum of 2 traps should be used regardless of field size.

HOW MANY TRAPS TO USE:

Usually 4 traps per monitored plot is recommended.

SERVICING THE TRAP:

The long life lures will last the duration of the season (ie 6 months). The trap should be changed when high insect catches or dusty conditions have led to the deterioration of the glue surface. It is recommended that at each reading the trapped insects and any other debris be removed.

OBSERVATIONS AND DATA RECORDING:

Catches should be recorded weekly in low populations but more frequently in groves with high populations. Record the trap catch on a trap record sheet.

STORAGE AND HANDLING

The traps and lures should be stored in a cool dry place in their original packaging until ready for use. The lures should be kept refrigerated or frozen. Please lure Technical Data Sheet for more specific details.
